

#### Important Tips for Assembling Your Zilenzio Products

#### Handle Packaging with Care

When opening the packaging, use a knife carefully to avoid damaging the product.

#### Create a Safe Unpacking Space

Lay a blanket, use the inside of the box, or ensure the floor is clean and free from debris to protect your product during unpacking.

#### Keep It Clean


Always handle the products with clean hands to preserve their finish and appearance.

#### **Mindful Placement**

Place unassembled items gently. This small step helps protect the finish and ensures the products look flawless when assembled.

#### Avoid Sharp or Hard Surfaces

Never lean the products against sharp edges or hard surfaces. Doing so can cause indentations in the wooden frame or filling, which can be difficult to restore.



# Important safety instructions

Read these instructions carefully before commencing installation and retain for future reference.

- The luminaire should be installed by a licened electrician and in accordance with local regulations. Make sure that the power is off before installation or maintenance.


# Assembly Instructions Hikari

## Installation

Insert the wire into the gripper.

Always insert the wire through

the pin unless otherwise stated.



Press the pin and adjust up. When

you press the pin the lock opens

and the gripper slides on the wire. Release pin to lock again.

the way through the gripper and protrude at least

0.2 inch from the bottom.

Adjust the gripper down. When you

let go of the gripper it will automati-cally lock iteslf on the wire.
